By Signing this form I agree that you are the person whose identification appears overleaf and you hereby acknowledge that:

- A. You are the the receiver of the above mentioned vehicle.
- B. You will not allow any other person to take custody or to drive the vehicle without written approval from the dealership.
- C. You will maintain the vehicle in good working order and condition.
- D. You hold a valid & unrestricted Australian motor vehicle driver's license for this vehicle
- E. You accept full responsibility for the vehicle including all of it's parts and accessories:
 - i) For loss or damage occuring to or occasioned by the vehicle until it's returned to the dealership.
 - ii) For the cost of repairing damage caused deliberately, carelessly or recklessly by you or by your passengers.
 - iii) To carry out any puncture repair in accordance with safety legislation
- F. You will return the vehicle at the time agreed, as noted overleaf, and will immediately advise the the dealership if the vehicle cannot be returned by the appointed time.
- G. You will be responsible for any and all recovery costs the dealership may incur if you do not return the vehicle at the dealership you picked it up from at the appointed time.
- H. Where damage is claimable under the dealership's insurance policy you will pay the excess shown, including any age or penalty excess applied by your insurer.
- I. You will pay for any tolls, fines, or infringement notices (including legal costs & expenses) that arise whilst the vehicle is in your control.
- J. You agree not to drive the vehicle outside of the Sydney Metropolitan area.


- K. In the event the said motor vehicle is damaged whilst in my care and control and I am under the influence of intoxicating alcohol, drugs or found guilty of driving in either a dangerous or negligent manner You will be solely responsible for the cost of repairs to the damage on the occasioned vehicle.
- L. You agree you will not leave the motor vehicle keys in the vehicle or ignition when you exit the motor vehicle on all occasions. If the motor vehicle is stolen and you have been found negligent of this

you will be solely responsible for the cost of repairs , if damaged, or the amount equal to the cost, if it is not recovered, of the said motor vehicle.

You must not, under any circumstances:

- A. Smoke or consume any food or drink whilst in possession of the above mentioned vehicle.
- B. Allow pets or animals in the vehicle
- C. Allow the vehicle to be sublet or let the vehicle on hire, rideshare service.
- D. Allow the vehicle to be used to carry passengers or goods for payment of any kind
- E. Use the vehicle off-road or use the vehicle on any other surface other than a sealed road or use the vehicle on a flooded roadway where the police or any other government authority has issued a warning or caution.

Toll notice implications: If you go through a toll without your personal TAG you will be forwarded the toll fine and an administration fee will be charged to you by the Toll company.

The Privacy Act 1988 - Information

For example, in handling claims, we may have to disclose your personal information to third parties such as other insurers, loss adjusters, investigators agents and others involved in the claims handling process, or as required by law.

We limit the use and disclosure of any personal information provided by us to them for the specific purpose for which we supplied it.

you have the right to seek access to your personal and sensitive information and correct it at any time.

We aim to ensure that your personal information is accurate, up-to-date and complete.

Please contact the firm manager if you would like to access or revise your personal information, or feel that the information we have currently on our record is incorrect, incomplete, or if you believe that the privacy of your personal information has been interfered with. In these cases you are entitled to raise your concerns.
